"With faith, discipline and selfless devotion to duty, there is nothing worthwhile that you cannot achieve."

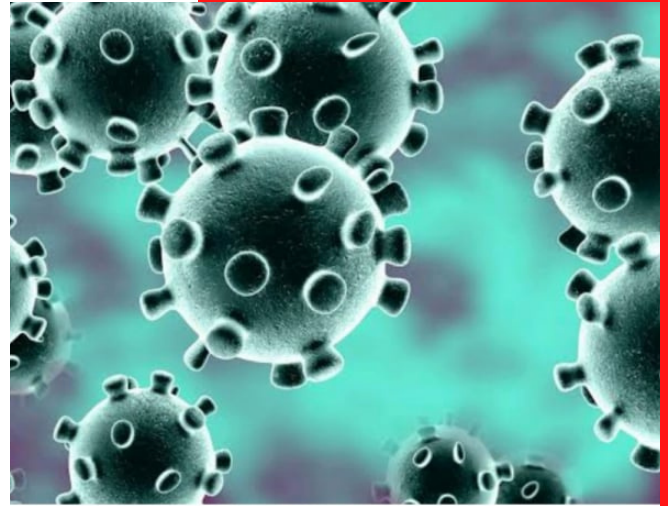
We promise our students an opportune environment for academic excellence and personality grooming; an environment of fairness while we celebrate our diversity.

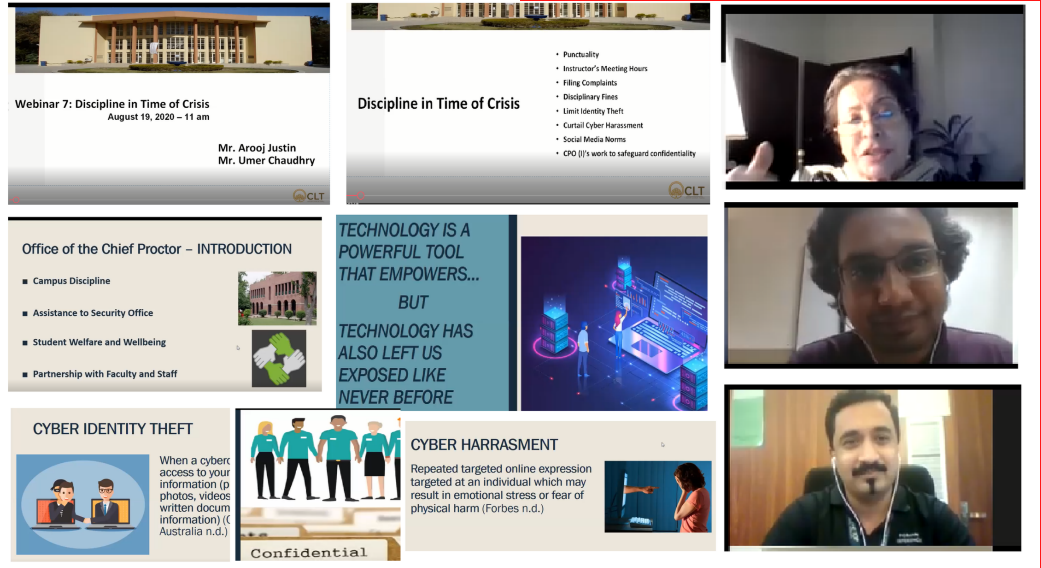
COLLEGE ADMISSION CAMPAIGN

STUDENT ORIENTATION VIDEO

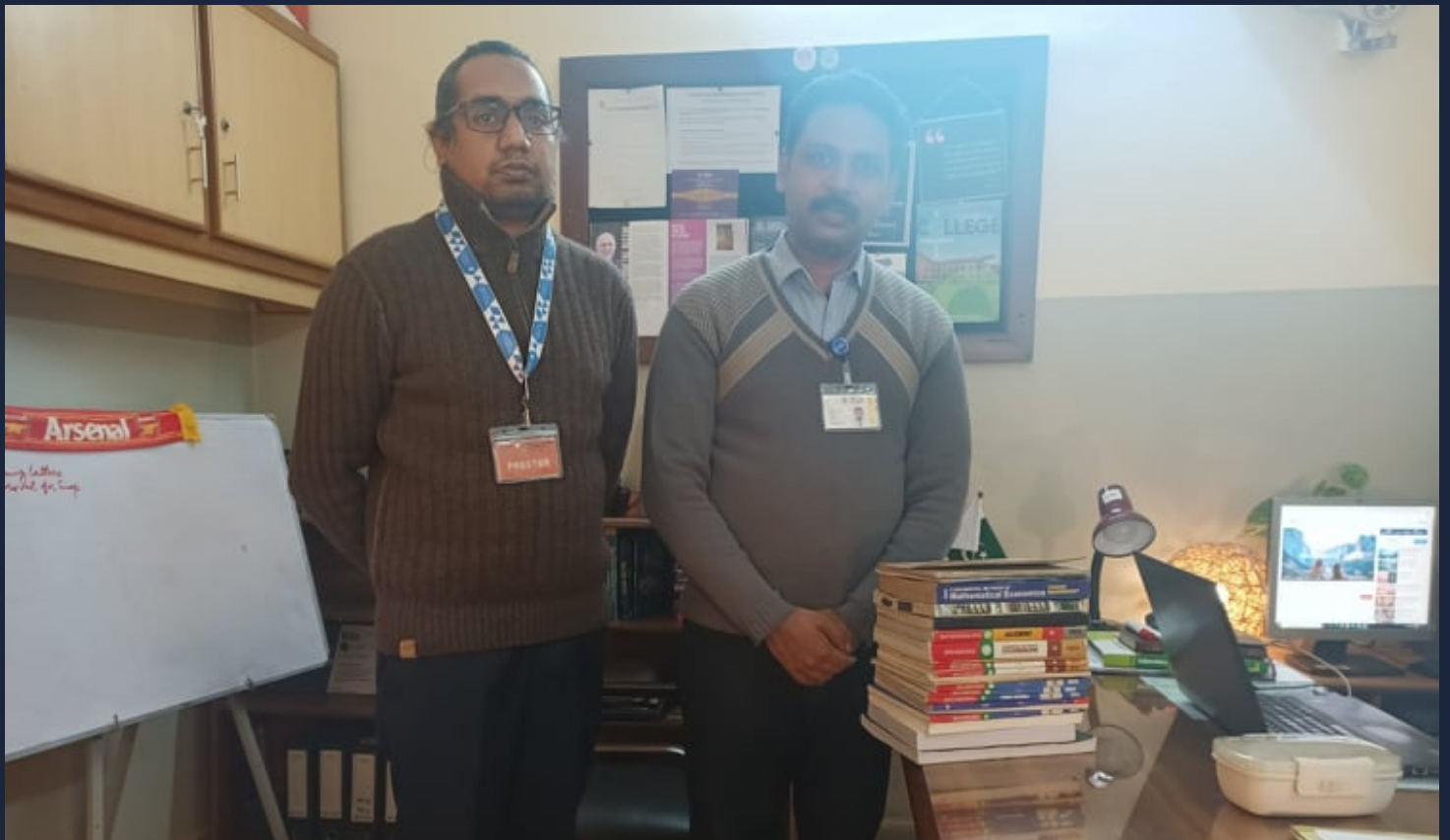
CPO was given the assignment of producing student orientation video. The project was successfully completed and showcased to the college students during 'Character Building' lessons.
