Message from founding Director of the Centre for Public Policy and Governance

Information Technology (IT) is transforming social relations, multiplying economic opportunities, and widening political power equations across Pakistan and the world in unprecedented ways. The speed, scale, and reach of IT have made geographical boundaries insignificant yet volatile, as the media documents the reality of violence across societies. IT has also heightened awareness with reference to race, religion, economics, ethics, and sustainability. Increasingly, social media has become a platform to spread hate and this must be curbed and changed. The recent horrendous terrorist attacks in New Zealand and Sri-Lanka are a relevant example of the reach that social media can attain. To comprehend these transformations the challenge is to understand how IT gives new meaning to connectivity, interdisciplinary, and critical thinking in higher education. At FCCU, the ITS Department is performing multiple functions in improving connectivity on the campus; it has helped develop communications across the campus. 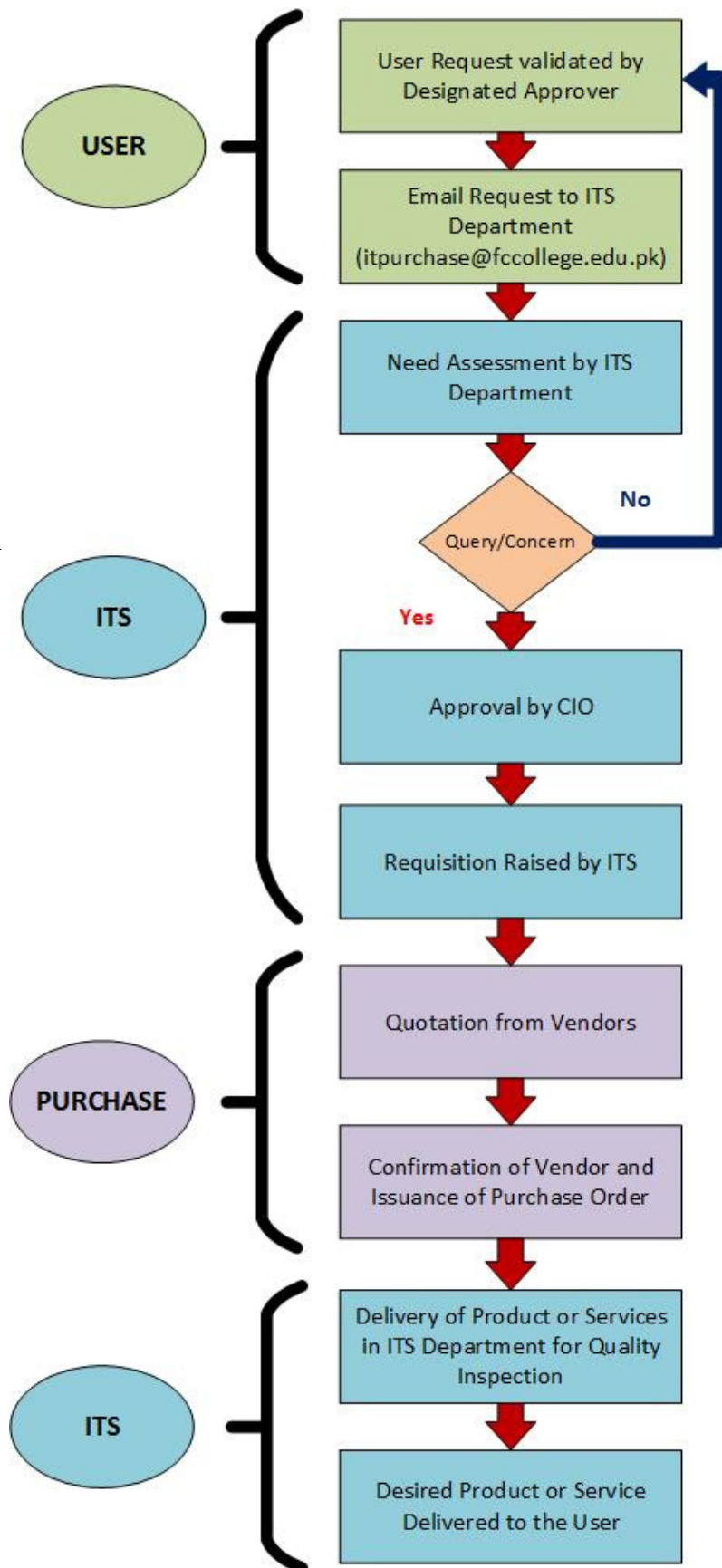

INSTALLING MOODLE APP ON SMART PHONES

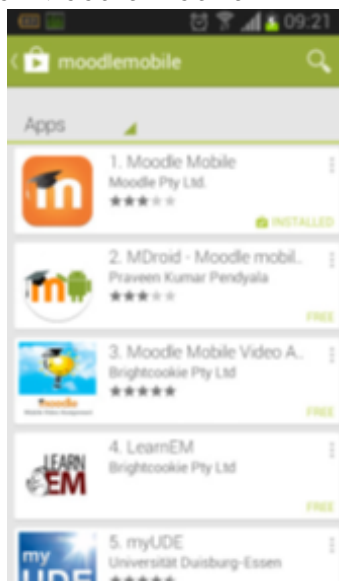
The new version of moodle (3.5+) is configured for integration with moodle's mobile app. This app provides great facilitation for students and faculty to utilize moodle via smart-phones.

With the Moodle app, you can learn wherever you are, whenever you want, with these app features:

1. Easily access course content - browse the content of your courses, even when offline
2. Connect with course participants - quickly find and contact other people in your courses
3. Keep up to date - receive instant notifications of messages and other events, such as assignment submissions
4. Submit Turnitin Assignments - Upload images, audio, videos and other files from your mobile device
5. Track your progress - View your grades, check completion progress in courses and browse your learning plans
6. Complete activities anywhere, anytime - attempt quizzes, post in forums, play SCORM packages, edit wiki pages and more - both on and offline (docs.moodle.org, 2018)

Following are the steps to install Moodle mobile app:

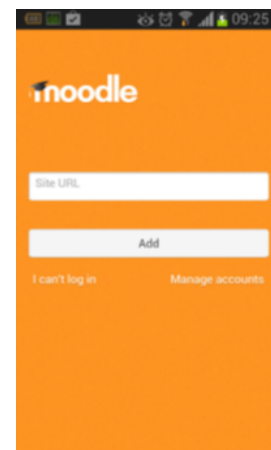
1. On your Android Smart phone , Open Playstore and search for Moodle mobile



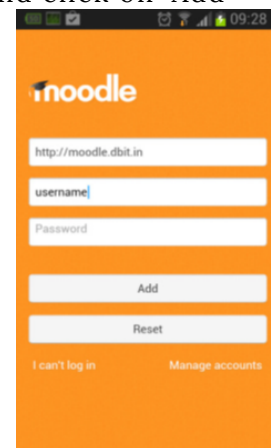
2. Select Moodle Mobile App and Install. (please ensure that you install moodle app and not moodle classic)



3. After installation open the App



4. Enter url - `tmoodle.fccollege.edu.pk/moodle`
5. Enter Your FCCU Moodle username and password and click on 'Add'



6. After login click on 'My Courses' to choose your course.
